Notes:

- A Demonstration-Year runs from just after the final demonstration of one Festival until just after the final demonstration of the next year's Festival.
- One Curry Point is accumulated for participation in any Demonstration (whether during the formal Demonstration Season or not) except that participation in a Demonstration on a Saturday counts double.
- Curry Points may not be traded, mortgaged or be the subject of a 'futures' market.
- There are four ways in which a ringer's points total may be reset to zero:
 1. By attending a post-Festival Curry (that's what it's all about!).
 2. By agreeing to participate in a Demonstration but failing to turn up.
 3. By not participating in any Demonstrations for three successive years.
 4. By losing out when the entire slate was wiped clean on 4 August 1986.
- All ringers shown in the left-hand table above but not the right-hand table either attended the post-Festival Curry on 16 August 2003 or dropped off the list by Rule 3.
- The provisional date for the next Curry is Wednesday 3 August 2005. Those in the top seven places of the league table at the end of the 2004–2005 Demonstration-Year will qualify. Any ties for the lower places will be resolved by drawing lots.
